# SESSION DATES

## **PEDIATRIC ONCOLOGY CAMPS**

- For families who have a newborn *to 7 year-old* who has been diagnosed with cancer (**July 8-10 & July 11-13**)
- For families who have an *8 to 12 year-old* who has been diagnosed with cancer (**August 12-14 & August 15-17**)
- For families who have a *13 to 18 year-old* who has been diagnosed with cancer (**July 29-31 & August 1-3**)

## **PARENT ONCOLOGY CAMPS**

- For families who **have a parent/guardian** who has been diagnosed with or had been treated for cancer within the past **five years** (**July 15-17, July 18-20, & July 22-24**)

## **SICKLE CELL ANEMIA FAMILY CAMPS**

- For families who have a parent or child in their household who has been diagnosed and treated for sickle cell anemia (**July 25-27**)

## **BEREAVEMENT FAMILY CAMPS**

- For families who have **lost a parent/child** with cancer or sickle cell anemia within the past **five years** (**August 5-7 & August 8-10**)

**Please Note:** These sessions are offered at a **LIMITED CAPACITY** with priority given to new Camp Good Days families, newly diagnosed or bereaved families, and families in active treatment.

**Session dates are subject to change.**

## **MORNING PROGRAM**

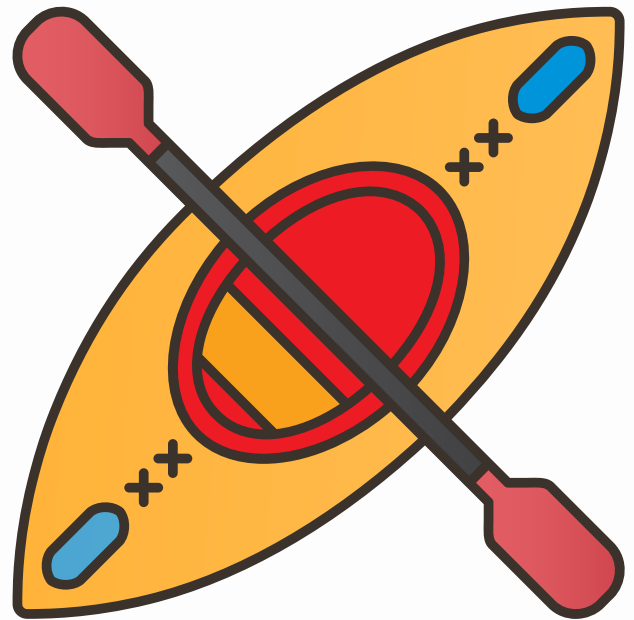

## **DAY PROGRAM**

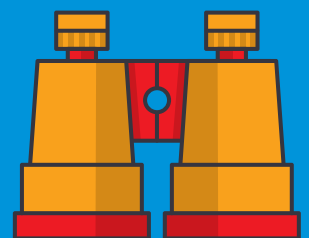
- Nature Walk

# HEALTH & SAFETY

---

Adjustments to our typical day-to-day camp operations will be made in order to best mitigate the risks of COVID-19.

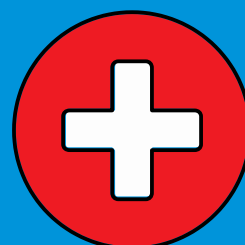
## HEALTH SCREENING

- Upon arrival, all participants, including volunteers & staff will go through a health screening (temperature checks & symptom reviews). *Screenings will be conducted daily.*
- Mask wearing will be enforced for all participants over age two

## CLEANING & SANITIZATION

- To limit shared program materials, each family will receive their own materials upon check-in
- High traffic areas & shared equipment will be cleaned and disinfected by Camp staff regularly following CDC recommendations
- Hand sanitizing & disinfecting stations will be made available in every building, program area, and cabin.

In the event that a camp participant begins to exhibit any COVID-19 related symptoms, they (and their family) will be asked to leave the facility to help mitigate the potential spread of the virus.



# LIVING ARRANGMENTS

---

## MEALS

- Our food service crew are prepared to follow the practices recommended by the CDC and the State/Local Department of Health at the time of the program
- Mealtimes may be staggered to reduce occupancy and congregations
- Dietary Needs/ Food Allergies: If you have either, please indicate those on your application form

## HOUSING

- Each family will be assigned to their own cabin
- Toilets, sinks, and shower stalls are available in all cabins
- All beds are single bunked beds
- Please note, none of our cabins are equipped with AC, so we recommend bringing a fan
- WiFi is available in certain locations; internet & social media policies & information will be reviewed at check-in
- Sanitizing supplies will be available in all cabins

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19, all participants must stay on-site for the duration of the program, unless there is an emergency.

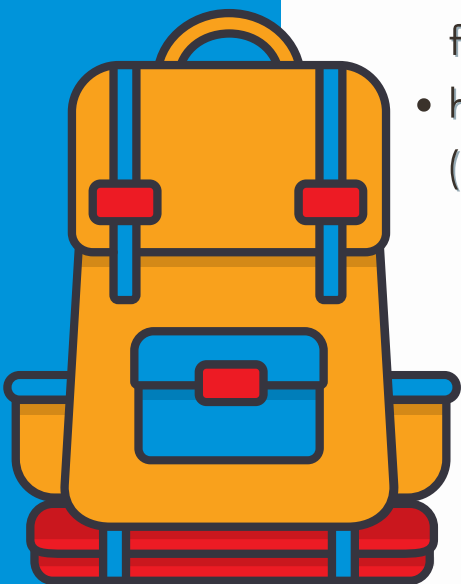
