<b>Office/ Camp Store Manager</b>	Responsible for maintaining the camp store and office, answering phones and directing calls as needed, checking in and assisting any visitors, keeping basic record of inventory in camp store and reporting to the Camp Director; will help out in other program areas as needed. Experience working in office setting preferred.
<b>Sports &amp; Recreation Specialist</b>	Sports Specialist areas include teaching sports, activities, and field games. Responsible for planning and implementing sports & games activities under supervision of Camp Director. Must have experience leading activities.
<b>Arts &amp; Crafts Specialist</b>	Responsible for planning and implementing Arts & Crafts activities, assisting in training of staff in his/her specialty area, maintenance of program area and supplies. Also responsible for leading daily activities that are meaningful for campers, such as creating journals, creating collages, etc.
<b>Music &amp; Drama Specialist</b>	Responsible for planning and implementing Music & Drama activities, assisting in training of staff in his/her specialty area, maintenance of program area and supplies. Responsible for leading daily activities that are fun (i.e. charades, talent show, play performances, music lessons, etc.) and meaningful for campers (i.e. drumming circles).
<b>Nature &amp; Science Specialist</b>	Responsible for planning and implementing Nature & Science activities, assisting in training of staff in his/her specialty area, maintenance of program area and supplies. Responsible for leading daily activities that are fun and meaningful (i.e. hikes, canoe trips, science experiments, etc.)
<b>Program Staff</b>	Report directly to the Camp Director. Responsible for helping specialist in program areas as needed. Must be willing and excited to learn about all program areas. Will receive basic training from specialists in all program areas on leading and implementing projects, games and activities. Help plan and implement "all-camp activities." (It is preferred that program staff are, or are willing to become lifeguard certified, training will be provided)
<b>Full-time Lifeguard</b>	Responsible for lifeguarding at the pool and waterfront during all games and activities, maintaining clean and safe swim areas at the pool and waterfront, assisting with implementation of pool games and canoe trips under supervision of the Aquatics Director. Must be lifeguard certified. Experience working with children preferred.
<b>Kitchen Specialist</b>	The Kitchen Specialists are responsible for the operation of the dining areas and maintenance of their cleanliness. Kitchen Specialists will report to the Kitchen Manager, and Camp Director. Kitchen staff will help prep, cook, and expedite daily meal service, help maintain kitchen inventory and equipment, and help maintain cleanliness of kitchen. The Kitchen Specialists work with the Kitchen Manager and summer staff in planning and packing food trips away from camp. They will assist with cabin watch and participate in other camp activities when not fulfilling kitchen duties.
<b>Camp Photographer</b>	The Camp Photographer is responsible for photographing and videoing daily camp activities. They will be responsible for archiving and sending the documents to the Social Media Coordinator. Will receive basic training in all program areas, and will assist with projects, games and activities at the discretion of the Camp Director.
