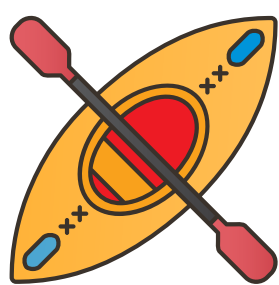




JOIN OUR SUMMER STAFF TEAM!
